Terms and Conditions

These tuition fees apply to overseas/international students only. Total fees quoted are inclusive of learning materials and resources unless specified otherwise. Course duration and hours may vary for students who are granted RPL. Duration weeks are inclusive of study breaks during the course.

What is RPL?

RPL refers to recognition of prior learning and is the process whereby a person's skills and experience is matched and assessed against the studies and qualification they are seeking. More information can be found in the [Skills Recognition](#) page on the college website at www.taie.com.au. Students wishing to apply for RPL should contact TAIE prior to applying for enrolment. The cost of RPL if not for the whole qualification is \$250 per unit of competency.

Payment of Fees

Students are required to pay a non-refundable \$200 fee on enrolment application. Upon application acceptance a Letter of Offer will be issued to students outlining fee details, course commencement dates and overseas student health cover requirements. To accept the offer students will be required to pay the requested fees by the due date.

As an approved CRICOS provider, TAIE adheres to the requirements of the Australian Government Tuition Protection Service as such TAIE will not be requesting or requiring students to pay more than \$1500 of total tuition fees prior to course commencement. Once courses commence, students will be invoiced progressively on a monthly basis such that at any given time, the total amount required to be paid will be no more than \$1,500.

Refunds

Refunds apply in instances where notification of withdrawal is received by The Academy of International Education (Australia) prior to the course commencement. For full details of notice requirement and refund amounts please refer to the Refund Policy & Procedure available at www.taie.com.au

Other Fees
